From time to time, I may issue updates to information, itinerary or events for our San Antonio trip. This is the second of those updates. When time gets closer, I will combine everything into one final schedule.

Update #2 Event: Due to popular demand, we will try to fit in a lunch or mid-afternoon snack at the Scenic Loop Café. This little café is owned by George Strait (you should know who that is) and is located next to a large corral/roping area out in the country about nine miles southwest of Boerne. If you remember, George Strait's hobby is competitive team calf roping. This is where he and his brother practice as well as other horse/cattle activities going on. Will we see him? Who knows? Update #1 Event: Day/afternoon trip, perhaps in conjunction with the day trip to Fredericksburg--Sister Creek Winery located in Sisterdale, Tx. (pop. 25). It's out in the REAL Texas hill country north of Boerne. Nice drive through the country. Will wait to set a day/time 'til Group 2 decides on their schedule. The last time I was in Sisterdale, I was driving my new 1985 Corvette with 200 miles on it when a deer jumped out in front of me. It scooted across the hood and only left a small hoof scuff.

The following is information, proposed itinerary and schedule for those who will go with Group 1:

2. During the week/weekend of the car show, it is also Fiesta time in San Antonio. The car show is an official Fiesta event even though it is held in Boerne instead of downtown San Antonio. For those not familiar with Fiesta, it's kind of like San Antonio's version of Mardi Gras. Here is a link to the activities:

3. Travel Itinerary: Depart Biloxi from the Pilot Truck Stop at Exit 44 at 6:00AM, April 13 and drive straight through to Boerne, TX. Those who live to the west of Biloxi can join the group as we pass along. Expected arrival time should be approximately 4:30 - 5:00PM. We will make potty stops as needed and one quick lunch stop possibly in Orange or Beaumont, TX. We will travel I-10(I-12 from Slidell to Baton Rouge), all the way to Exit 587 just east of San Antonio using Charles Anderson Loop (Loop 1604) to skirt the northside of San Antonio and get back on I-10 in north/northwest San Antonio and proceeding to Boerne 20 miles further on. Depending on weather/traffic conditions, there is an alternate route that we may take to skirt San Antonio since we will be arriving there during rush hour.

Return To Biloxi: For those who don't wish to go on the Hill Country tour on Sunday the 18th, you could depart Boerne at your convenience. For those who do go on the Hill Country tour, we will leave Boerne early Monday morning and drive straight through back to Biloxi.

During the trip, we will communicate by cell phone. At a later time I will ask each of you for your cell phone number and will make a composite list to provide to each car.

4. Schedule of Events: (tentative and very fluid depending on consensus, weather, etc.

A. Wednesday and/or Thursday: Day trip to Fredericksburg, TX. for sightseeing, visiting the Adm. Nimitz WWII museum and having dinner one or more nights at Freidhelm's Restaurant in Fredericksburg. There are other nice, authentic German restaurants in town that you can select from if you wish.

B. Friday (daytime): Visit downtown San Antonio/Riverwalk. Recommend we do this and exit downtown prior to about 2:00PM because Friday afternoon traffic in San Antonio is absolute murder plus they will begin blocking off many streets for Fiesta events causing even more turmoil.

C. Saturday: Leave hotel going to car show area. Recommend about 8:30AM. Show area is approximately two miles from the hotel. For those needing to cleanup their car(most of us), there is a coin op car wash about 1 1/2 miles from the hotel.

Boerne is a quaint little town and has some interesting shops within three to four blocks of the show area. Good way to kill time after you've seen all the cars.

D. I have not included any info on the Friday night Sock Hop nor the After Show Dinner. See the TCA link to the show above for info on those. I can provide more info, location of those events, etc. if you are interested.
