## **“A DAY IN OUR CAPITOL CITY”**

We shall begin the day by meeting at the SHELL station off exit 206 of I 10 in LaPlace at 9:30 in the morning. Exit right off I 10 West.

From there we will travel together to the **Enchanted Mansion-A Doll Museum**, 190 Lee Drive. We will exit the Interstate at the Highland Road Exit, #166 and travel on Highland Road until we reach Lee Drive. Turn right at Lee Drive and the museum will be in that first block on your right. At this time of the year the museum features a special display of Angel dolls. The fee to visit this museum is \$4.50 or \$3.50 if you are a senior citizen, payable at the door. We will have a guided tour and enjoy tea and refreshments.

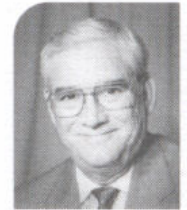
